The Wissahickon is a recreational resource and drinking water source for thousands of area residents. We can't afford any more threats to the quality of the Creek!

A proposed 17-story highrise along the banks of the Wissahickon Creek in Ambler **threatens the Creek and our drinking water with:**

- **Polluted runoff**—the number one polluter of our waterways. Increases in paved surfaces means more pesticides, fertilizer, oil, gasoline and other toxins in the Wissahickon.
- **More treated sewage in the Creek**—370 units will create at least 7.3 million gallons per year of additional sewage effluent to be dumped into the Wissahickon.
- **The highrise would be built on an old asbestos dump.** Release of asbestos into our air and water during construction could have dangerous health effects.

Please help stop this proposal before it further impairs the Wissahickon Creek!
